Why not try your hand at some fishing?
Our fishing lakes are suitable for both beginners & experienced anglers. It's a great way to spend a peaceful afternoon. Lakes are stocked with Rainbow Trout ranging from 1lb up to 8lb weight.

Red Deer: You can often see red deer in the fields surrounding the woodland in early morning and at dusk. Keep an eye out amongst the trees as well.



Foxes: Keep an eye amongst the trees. Baby foxes often come out from their dens to play during the day.



Buzzards: An abundance of these birds of prey call the woodland their home. Keep an eye out in the sky above and you may see them soar.



Red Squirrels: Watch high up in the trees for native red squirrels as they jump from branch to branch.



Hare: Watch for hares. These speedy rabbits can be seen running through the woodland.



Badgers: Look carefully among the trees. Badgers are rarely seen during the day but they are known to move from sett to sett.
